From the Pastor...

An important decision is upon us. It isn't difficult but it has to be made. The Elders and the Council are considering a "new" way to structure the church. It would be new to us but it is a Biblical model. The proposal is for the Elders to be responsible for the church's teaching (and everything that goes with it). Being responsible does not mean that the Elders "run things." It would mean that the Elders lead (shepherd; sheep are led not driven!). The Elders are mentioned several times in God's Word as the established leaders of the churches. There was at least one Council mentioned (Acts 15). They were the Apostles and Elders! They decided the question at hand. They met once for only the one question. We do not read of another meeting. However, Elders were established in other towns (Acts 14:23, 15:2, 20:17, 21:8, 1 Timothy 4:14, 5:17, Titus 1:5, 1 Peter 5:5) Elders were the leaders of the churches. DCC Elders led the congregation through the issues on ordination. They did well. The "system" has already been proven by our own experience. Still, we must go through our present channels to make any changes. Therefore, the DCC Council votes on March 20th whether to recommend this change to the congregation. If they do, the congregation will meet and vote on March 24th whether to TRY this out. (We would institute a six month TRIAL period.) If the changes do not seem to work, we revert back to our present structure. Any questions? Materials and charts are available at the church. Please make an informed decision. Peace.

This Month in Daleville Christian Church History



[Technically, there is no history of Daleville Christian Church to view. Before, we were always Daleville Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). But because our heritage has brought us here to 2013, we will look back and celebrate the highlights and struggles through which our Lord brought us.]

March weather can be brutal! Six of the deadliest tornadoes in Indiana occurred in the month of March. But who will forget March 2012—the warmest on record following the fourth warmest winter on record? Some will remember lilacs blooming six weeks early!

March 2003: the end of winter; the winter of 2002-3 was the fifth coldest and the second snowiest on record.

First week of <u>March 2012</u>: Tornadoes struck Indiana two different days. Both sets of storms were destructive and deadly (February 29th, 7 states). On <u>March 2nd</u>, Indiana and Kentucky were hardest hit. Eighteen states had storms. It was the region's deadliest outbreak of tornadoes in nearly 40 years.

<u>March 11, 1918</u> Albert Gitchell at Fort Riley, Kansas falls ill with what would be the world wide flu pandemic, killing 50 million people.



March 17th: (St. Patrick's Day) Besides a day and within a day of some church birthdays, we celebrate our Irish heritage. 36 million people claim Irish ancestry, almost 1 million Hoosiers. An estimated 2 million people will watch the annual parade in NYC.

<u>March 19, 1918</u>: Congress enacts Daylight Saving Time, Uniform start and end dates are established in 1966 and by 2008 all states but Arizona and Hawaii participate.

<u>March 21,1968</u>: The General Board of Daleville Christian Church heard a detailed report of the proposal to open a day care center at the church.

March 23, 2008: Easter Sunday; the earliest Easter since 1913! Easter, unlike other holidays is a "lunar" holiday rather than a date. Easter is celebrated on the first Sunday following the first full moon after the equinox (March 21st) This follows ancient tradition to follow the Jewish calendar for Passover but to always celebrate on a Sunday. (Jesus' crucifixion and resurrection occurred around Passover.)

CHRISTIAN WOMEN'S FELLOWSHIP:


