Gift Suggestions!

TOYS: Dolls, toy trucks, stuffed animals, kazoo's, harmonicas, yo-yos,
jump ropes, balls, toys that light up and make noise (you can include extra batteries
SCHOOL SUPPLIES: Pens, pencils, sharpeners, crayons, markers, stamps, ink pad sets,
writing pads, paper, solar calculators, coloring books, picture books.
HYGIENE ITEMS: Toothbrush, mild bar soap (in a plastic bag), comb, washcloth.
ACCESSORIES: T-shirts, socks, ball caps, sunglasses, hair clips, toy jewelry, watches,
flashlights (with extra batteries).

A PERSONAL NOTE: You may enclose a note to the child and a photo of yourself or family. If
you include your name and address the child may write back.
